Topic: Types of Forest

Instructions: Match the following characteristics with each type of forest.

1. Closed Broadleaf -

- Forest has a single tree up to 30m high; has stilt roots

2. Disturbed Broadleaf -

- Forest where crowns are not in contact; forest is shorter on slopes with height up to 15m

3. Secondary -

- Disturbance is between 10%-25%

4. Short Open Dry -

- Closed canopy; contains diverse flora; trees are at least 5m tall

5. Tall Open Dry -

- Open shrubs; crowns are not in contact; height of 1-5m

6. Swamp -

- Grows in brackish (salty) water; trees have pneumatophores

7. Mangrove -

- Has specie such as the Broke Axe showing disturbance in the forest.
