What is a "sawmill"?

Sawmill means any power driven saw whether circular saw, band saw, or any other type of saw capable of being used for cross-cutting or sawing timber into boards or planks.

A SAWMILL LICENCE IS REQUIRED TO:

Drive, transport or use in any place a sawmill of any type of make.

Authorise or instruct anyone to use or operate your saw.

Trade, store or purchase locally produced lumber.

STEPS TO OBTAINING YOUR SAWMILL LICENCE

Complete an application form available on our website and at our offices islandwide.



Submit the complete form and pay the Submit the completed application fee.



Pay the licensing fee upon approval of your application.



Collect your Sawmill Licence when notified.
